
The following points were discussed and approved by B.O.S members for the academic year 2023-2024 syllabus.

The following points were discussed for the betterment of curriculum, syllabi and course of BBA Programme from the academic year 2021-22 and 2022-23. The academic year 2023-24 syllabus has been framed as per the TANSHE regulations of the parent university.


The main points discussed in the meeting:

1. The Board resolved and approved the scheme of examination, syllabi, and regulations for the students admitted in the BBA program from the academic year 2023 – 2024 onwards as per TANSHE Guidelines.
2. The Board resolved and approved the Allied Courses for the students of BBA admitted from the academic year 2022-2023 onwards.
3. The incorporation of Tamil paper re-set for the students admitted in the academic year 2022-23 and certain papers have been re-structured and modified.
4. The Board unanimously approved the Office Management paper has been eliminated.





Minutes of the Board of Studies
