69 students, 6 staff and one Project Coordinator visited and they were taken around all the departments and exposed to the conducive learning environment in

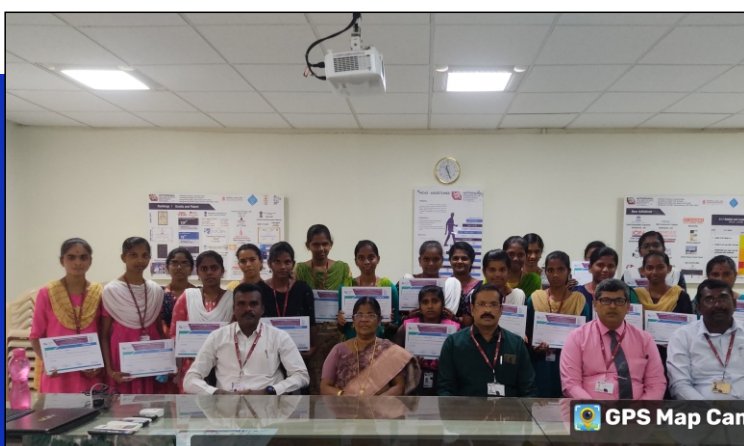
SKILL DEVELOPMENT CELL

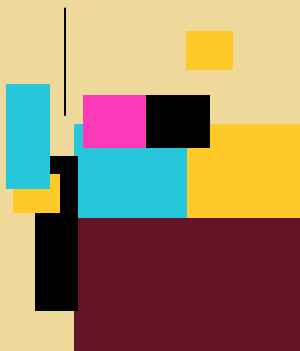

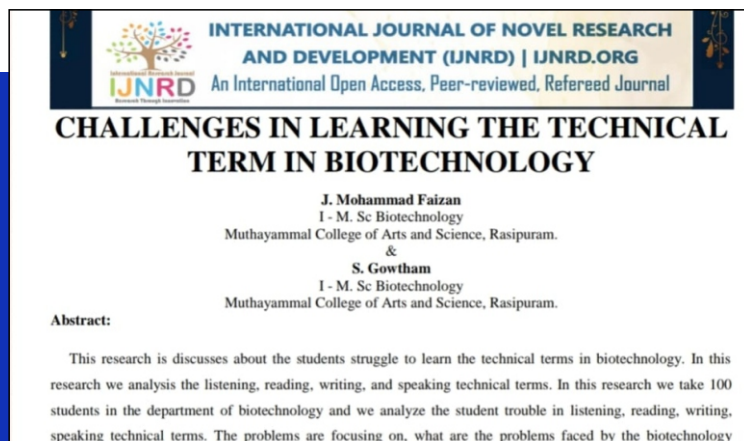


NESTS OF BIRDS - HEAVENLY BODIES

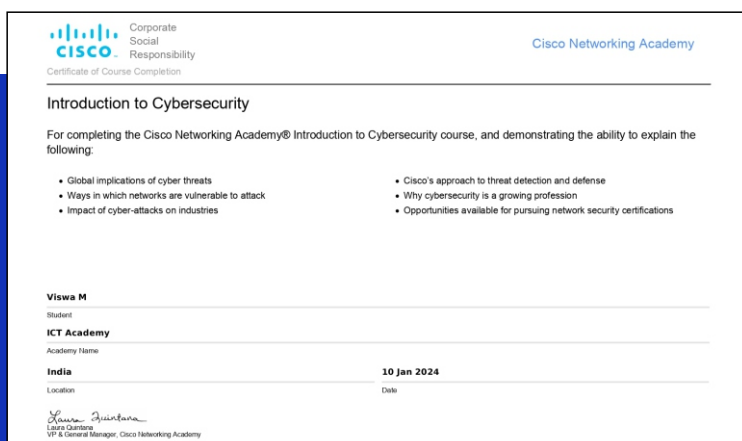
MAKE THE INVISIBLE VISIBLE & THE VISIBLE INVISIBLE
