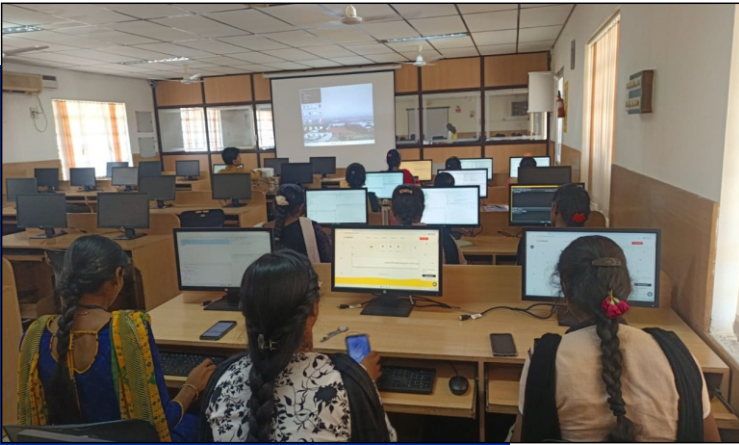




## VALUE ADDED COURSE

This remarkable event took place at Agaram Mahal, Rasipuram, celebrating creativity, dedication and record – breaking achievements.



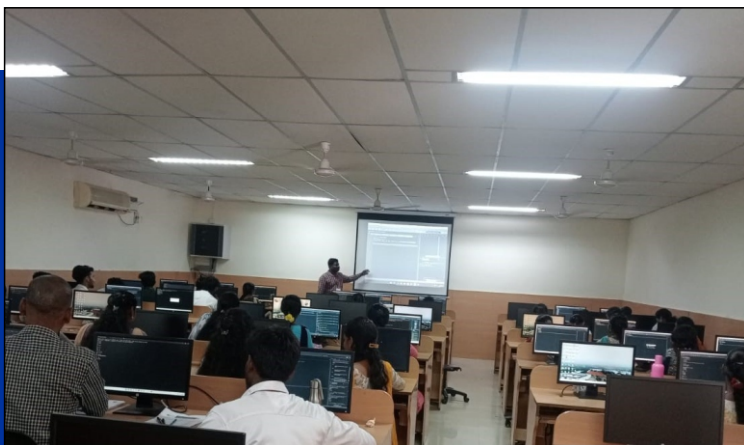
