EAT& RIGHT CAMPUS CERTIFICATION

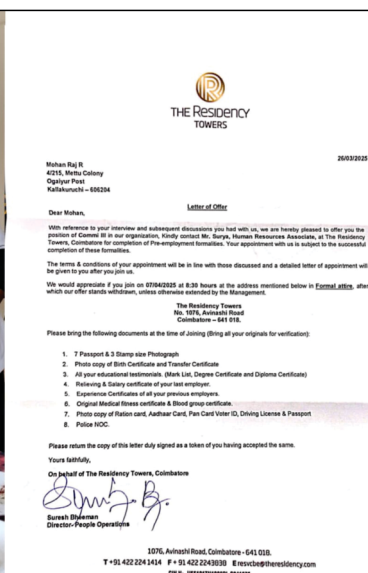
On 12.03.2025, department of Hotel Management and Catering Science received the highest score in the prestigious Eat Right Campus Certification by FSSAI.

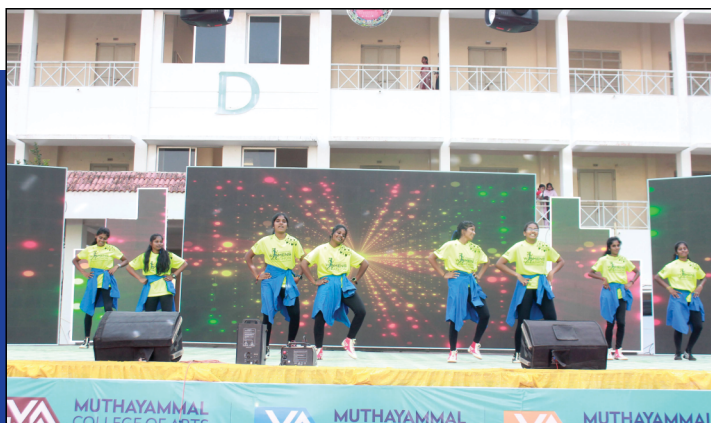


VMI CULTURAL FEST – 2K25
